The Department of Defense (DoD) declined to grant Applicant a security clearance. On May 21, 2020, DoD issued a statement of reasons (SOR) advising Applicant of the basis for that decision—security concerns raised under Guideline H (Drug Involvement and Substance Misuse) of Department of Defense Directive 5220.6 (Jan. 2, 1992, as amended) (Directive). Applicant

requested a decision on the written record. On February 17, 2021, after considering the record, Administrative Judge Gina L. Marine denied Applicant's request for a security clearance. Applicant appealed pursuant to Directive ¶ E3.1.28 and E3.1.30.

In his appeal brief, Applicant makes no assertion of harmful error on the part of the Judge. Rather, he states that he is sorry for having used illegal substances and promises not to make that mistake again.
